

Community Outreach Internship (Unpaid)

The North Clackamas Watersheds Council is seeking a Community Outreach Intern to support community engagement and volunteer coordination efforts during the spring and summer season. This internship offers hands-on experience in environmental outreach, volunteer engagement, and community education, and is a great opportunity to build professional skills while making meaningful connections in the community.

Community Outreach Interns play a key role in representing the Council at public events and supporting our volunteer-driven programs, particularly the Watershed Ambassador Program. Interns will work closely with Council staff and volunteers and gain exposure to nonprofit operations, event coordination, and environmental education.

Time Commitment

Approximately 5 hours per week, April–August. Scheduling is flexible and may include occasional evenings or weekends to support community events.

Primary Responsibilities

- Assist with coordination and communication for the Watershed Ambassador Program
- Represent the Council at community events, tabling opportunities, and outreach activities
- Provide logistical and on-site support for larger Council events
- Support streamside stewards workshops and other community education programs
- Help with general outreach preparation, including organizing materials and supplies

- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Comfortable working with volunteers and the public
- Reliable, organized, and able to work independently when needed
- Prior outreach or volunteer experience is helpful but not required
